

Meter Set Cost

The following is the schedule to be used to determine the amount of fees to be assessed for connecting to Limestone County Water & Sewer Authority's infrastructure.

** Impact fees will be assessed at a rate of \$1000 per residential equivalent based on the number and type of development units. The residential equivalent is based on water usage of 200 gallons per day.

** Impact fees for Industrial Customers with water usage above 1,000,000 gallons per month will be based on the obligated capacity needed by each entity or the capital improvement cost where existing infrastructure will not meet the demand of the entity.

Fire Line Tap Fee:

6" Fire Line	\$8000.00

All other fire line taps will be billed parts plus labor. These prices do not include a large meter. Fire lines will be installed with a 3/4" meter to monitor unauthorized flow.

If installation of any tap larger than 2" requires a road bore – an additional cost for the road bore and extra parts will be added to the total price.
